## 1.0 Organising Authority

The BBA Summer Series 3x3 Junior Competition is administrated and conducted by the Bunbury Basketball Association which is affiliated with Basketball WA.

## 2.0 Purpose

The BBA Summer Series 3x3 Junior Competition, for both Boys & Girls, is held in the January School Holidays for the purpose of establishing and encouraging social engagement, competition continuity and providing something different for the younger demographic in the sport of basketball.

## 3.0 Dates and Venue of Competition

The BBA Summer Series 3x3 Junior Competition will be held on the following dates:

- Tuesday 16<sup>th</sup> January 2024, Wednesday 17<sup>th</sup> January 2024 & Thursday 18<sup>th</sup> January 2024
- Subject to Registrations of individual players, consideration will be given to expanding to other extended times on each of these days
- Home venue will be South West Sports Centre, pending nomination numbers.

## 4.0 Age Groupings

The BBA Summer Series 3x3 Junior Competition, subject to nominations may have the following age groupings:

- Boys U12 (01/01/12 – 31/12/12), U14 (01/01/10 – 31/12/11), U16 (01/01/08 – 31/12/09), U18 (01/01/06 – 31/12/07)
- Girls U12 (01/01/12 – 31/12/12), U14 (01/01/10 – 31/12/11), U16 (01/01/08 – 31/12/09), U18 (01/01/06 – 31/12/07)
- If registration numbers do not allow for a specific age group to engage in fixtured rounds, these teams will be included in the next younger age group. In this case, these teams at the end of the competition will still be recognised in their registered age group regardless of the position they finish in the younger age group. (i.e. Highest Over 18s Girls team in the younger age group will be considered the highest finishing Over 18s Girls team and received recognition as such)

## 5.0 Eligibility to Participate

Any individual player is eligible to enter in their age group in the BBA Summer Series 3x3 Junior Competition.

It is preferred that players currently play in a Basketball WA affiliated association however, non-affiliated players/teams will pay an affiliation fee and be affiliated for the competition. All participants must be affiliated during the competition.

## 6.0 Registrations

**Player Registrations** – Each player must be registered & financial online prior to Monday 8<sup>th</sup> January 2024 4.00pm. This will include paying for the BWA Affiliation Fee (if required)

- Teams will be formed by BBA and participants notified before Monday 15<sup>th</sup> January.
- Bunbury Basketball Association's decision on acceptances and placement in teams

is final.

- Bunbury Basketball Association reserves the right to limit nomination numbers according to known capacities of facilities, referees or time restrictions.

## **7.0 Cost of Registrations**

The 2024 registration fee is \$55 per Player. There is an online registration process of which the fee needs to be paid electronically using PlayHQ.

There are no door fees to be charged for entry to the SWSC so you can come and go unchecked, however all players will be subject to the Bunbury Basketball Code of Conduct (outlined in the BBA Competition ByLaws).

## **8.0 Restrictions**

Players may not change from one team to another during the BBA Summer Series 3x3 Junior Competition

## **9.0 Player Nominations**

Each team may only select four (4) players for each game.

## **10.0 Competition Format**

Each team will play a minimum of 6 matches.

## **11.0 Finals Participation**

The finalists of the BBA Summer Series 3x3 Junior Competition will be the teams finishing in first place and second place on the ladder for each age group for Boys & Girls. A grand final will be played using the same game format as the qualifying rounds.

## **12.0 Referees**

Referees will be supplied and be paid by the Bunbury Basketball Association.

As a courtesy when one referee is on the court, it is anticipated that players will raise their hand or acknowledge their part, should the ball go out of court and being unsighted by the referee.

## **13.0 Score table Officials**

Volunteers will be used for required as Score table Official for each game, including Finals.

## **14.0 Fixtures**

The compilation of fixtures will be the responsibility of Bunbury Basketball Association. Commencement time will be advised at the earliest date and time once registrations are completed. If need be, some games maybe played earlier to ensure all fixtures are completed.

## 15.0 Equipment

All scoring devices and time-clocks will be supplied by SWSC & Bunbury Basketball Association.

No personal basketballs will be permitted during the competition.

## 16.0 Door Charges

The Player Registration Fee covers all personnel for entry.

## 17.0 Playing Rules

The BBA Summer Series 3x3 Junior Competition will be conducted as per the FIBA Rulebook with the following modifications:

- 17.1 Game Timing    20 minute time slots comprising of:
- Warm-up – Three (3) minutes
  - First Half - straight eight (8) minutes running clock from main clock.
  - Half Time - one (1) minutes
  - Second Half - straight eight (8) minutes running clock from the main clock,
  - Time Outs - one per half each team.
  - Shot Clocks will not be in use during the competition.
  - The Competition Coordinator reserves the right to reduce the game timing should for whatever reason, games have been delayed during the day so that the carnival can meet centre opening hours

### 17.2 Premiership Points

Qualifying Games	Win 2pts
	Draw 1pt
	Loss 0 pts

17.3 Drawn Games    **In Qualifying games**, the result of a drawn game is to stand. Each team's score will continue to accumulate for and against.

**In Finals games.** Each team will nominate a player to shoot three free-throws at the same end of the court with points added to the score to break the tie. Should the score remain a draw at the end of three free-throws, one shot will be taken alternatively by each player until someone misses their free-throw. Again, points will be added to the score.

- 17.5 24 Second Device      Not in use at the Bunbury Masters Carnival
- 17.6 Other Rules      No free throws will be taken during games. If a shooting foul is called, 2 points will be awarded to the shooter and the ball will be given to the other team.
- No time outs will be taken except for those called by the referee for injury or administration.
- 17.7 Final Placing      In the event of two or more teams being level on points for & against at the end of the qualifying games, position on the premiership table shall be on the basis of:
- a)      Qualifying game head to head.
  - b)      If the teams are still level, points **percentage** in the games played between the teams involved in the tie will be used.
  - c)      If teams have drawn or not all played one another in the tie, overall percentage will be used.
- 17.9 Code of Conduct      A "Code of Conduct" for players, parents and Officials will be adhered to for all teams in the Carnival. Teams will be responsible for the behaviour of their spectators.
- Players, team officials and spectators not abiding by the Code or Policy will be asked to leave the centre. Any player receiving two tech-fouls during the day will be automatically disqualified from participating in the remainder of the competition.**
- 17.10 Team Fouls      Four team foul each half with the fifth team foul (and subsequent fouls) resulting in one point to the player fouled.
- 17.11 Uniform      Players will not be allowed to take the court if they have pockets in their shorts. This includes zips, taped pockets and being worn inside out.
- 17.12 Mouthguards      All players **must** wear a mouthguard to participate in the carnival.

## **18.0 Tribunals**

Any alleged charges as a result of a report lodged by an official at the competition will be dealt with by a panel including the competition coordinator and association Officials, and an independent third panel member were possible. This panel will follow an Administrative Tribunal.

## **19.0 Photography**

Promotion carnival photos will be taken through the day however, should there be any objections

from participants, those photos will not be used for future promotions.

## 20.0 Items not provided for

Any matter not covered by the scope of these Rules, provided that it comes within the objects of the BBA, shall be dealt with by the Board of Directors of the Bunbury Basketball Association
